

3rd Round of Negotiations Indonesia-Chile CEPA Trade in Goods Negotiation

Indonesian delegation which chaired by the Director General of International Trade Negotiation, Iman Pambagyo, started the 3rd Round of Negotiations Indonesia-Chile CEPA Trade in Goods Negotiation in Santiago, Chile. Chilean delegation is headed by Director for Bilateral Economic Affairs -DIRECON, Pablo Urria. The 3rd Round of Indonesia-Chile CEPA Trade in Goods Negotiation continues the discussion and progress of the 2nd Round which was held previously on 13-14 March 2017 in Jakarta, Indonesia. Prior to the start of the negotiations, the two Delegates shared and updated the information through the breakfast meeting which was also attended by the Director of Bilateral Negotiations, Director of International Industrial Market Access, and Assistant Deputy for Economic Cooperation of America and Pacific and other Chile Delegations.

Indonesian Delegation Chairman Iman Pambagyo and Chile Delegation Chairman Pablo Urria started the Third Round of TIGs Indonesia-Chile CEPA Talks through Plenary Session. The negotiations were then divided into 5 Working Groups (WGs) and followed by no less than 13 Indonesian Delegates and 15 Chile Delegates.

On the sidelines of the negotiations, the Director General of International Trade Negotiations as Chairman of the Indonesian Delegation held a Courtesy Call with Chilean Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs Edgardo Riveros at the Chilean Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Santiago. The meeting discussed Indonesia's trade relations with Chile and the follow-up of Indonesia-Chile's CEPA 3rd Round which had been discussed at the head of state level during President Michelle Bachelet's visit to Jakarta on 11-12 May 2017.
