Panama recognizes the commitment it made in the World Trade Organization (WTO) to become a full participant in the WTO Information Technology Agreement (ITA). In order to do so, Panama must present a schedule of tariff commitments to the ITA Committee, which must approve the schedule. Panama has begun work on its schedule, and will consult with the Secretariat of the ITA Committee to resolve any outstanding technical issues. I am pleased to confirm that Panama will become a full participant in the ITA prior to the entry into force of the United States – Panama Trade Promotion Agreement.
