For procurement of construction services

(To be adjusted according to the formula in Section H, paragraph 3): \$6,725,000

For the three years following the entry into force of this Chapter, the threshold for procurement of goods and services applied by the procuring entities listed in Section A for Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua shall be \$117,100. At the end of the three-year period, the threshold shall be the same threshold as applied by the United States for the procurement of goods and services by the procuring entities listed in Section A. For the three years following the entry into force of this Chapter, the threshold for procurement of construction services by the procuring entities listed in Section A for Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua shall be \$8,000,000. At the end of the three-year period, the threshold shall be the same threshold applied by the United States for the procurement of construction services by the procuring entities listed in Section A.

1. This Chapter does not apply to procurements made by on Costa Rican entity from another Costa Rican entity.
2. This Chapter does not apply to government procurement programs on behalf of small, medium and micro enterprises (SME).

1. This Chapter does not apply to procurements made by one Nicaraguan entity from another Nicaraguan entity.
2. If, within three years after the entry into force of this Chapter, Nicaragua has implemented a procurement program on behalf of small, medium and micro enterprises, then Nicaragua shall consult with the other Parties to review the implementation of that program. Provided that all the Parties agree, Nicaragua shall be permitted to exempt procurement covered by such a program from coverage of this Chapter, provided that the

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program is applied in a transparent, predictable manner, and does not unfairly impair the balance of commitments the Parties have made.

Schedule of the United States

1. This Chapter does not apply to set asides on behalf of small and minority businesses. Set-asides include any form of preference, such as the exclusive right to provide a good or service and price preferences.
2. This Chapter does not apply to the procurement of transportation services that form a part of, or are incidental to, a procurement contract.

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Section H

Threshold Adjustment Formula

1. In calculating the value of a contract for the purpose of ascertaining whether the procurement is covered by this Chapter, a procuring entity shall include the maximum total estimated value of the procurement over its entire duration, taking into account all options, premiums, fees, commissions, interest and other revenue streams or other forms of remuneration provided for in such contracts.
2. The calculations of thresholds of goods and services referred to in Section A, shall be made in accordance with the following:
 - (a) The U.S. inflation rate shall be measured by the Producer Price Index for Finished Goods published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics;
 - (b) The first adjustment for inflation, to take effect on January 1, 2006, shall be calculated using the period from November 1, 2003 through October 31, 2005;
 - (c) All subsequent adjustments shall be calculated using two-year periods, each period beginning November 1, and shall take effect on January 1 of the year immediately following the end of the two-year period;
 - (d) The United States shall notify the Parties of the adjusted threshold values no later than November 16 of the year before the adjustment takes effect;
 - (e) The inflationary adjustment shall be estimated according to the following formula:

$$T_0 \times (1 + \Pi_i) = T_1$$

T_0 = threshold value at base period

Π_i = accumulated U.S. inflation rate for the "i"th two year-period

T_1 = new threshold value.

- (f) Except for El Salvador, which will use the value expressed by the United States in U.S. dollars, each Central American Party shall calculate and convert the value of the thresholds applicable to Section A, into its respective national currency using the conversion formula set out in sub-paragraph (g) of this Paragraph. Each Central American Party shall notify the United States of the value in its respective currency of the newly calculated thresholds no later than one month before the respective thresholds take effect; and

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(g) Each Central American Party shall use the conversion rate of its respective central bank. The conversion rates shall be the existing value of its respective currency in terms of U.S. dollars as of December 1 and June 1 of each year, or the first working day thereafter. The conversion rate as of December 1 shall apply from January 1 to June 30 of the following year, and as of June 1 shall apply from July 1 to December 31 of that year.

3. The calculation of thresholds referred to in Sections A, B, and C, shall be made in accordance with the following:
- (a) Each Party shall calculate and convert for itself the value of the threshold applicable to this paragraph into its respective national currency using the conversion rates published by the IMF in its monthly "International Financial Statistics." Each Party shall notify the other Parties without delay of the methodology that it used and the results of its calculations;
 - (b) The conversion rates shall be the average of the daily values of the respective national currency in terms of the Standard Drawing Right (SDR) over the two-year period preceding October 1 or November 1 of the year prior to the thresholds in national currency becoming effective, which shall be from January 1;
 - (c) Thresholds expressed in a national currency shall be adjusted every two years, with the first adjustment taking effect on January 1, 2006;
 - (d) The Parties agree that if a major change in a national currency vis-a-vis the SDR is made during a year and if such change were to create a significant problem with regard to the application of the Chapter, they shall consult as to whether an interim adjustment is appropriate.

Transition Mechanisms

1. During the two years following the entry into force of this Agreement, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua shall make best efforts to comply with the following provisions of this Chapter:
 - Article 9.4.2 (inclusion of an indication that the procurement is covered by this Chapter in the notice of intended procurement)
 - Article 9.5.1 (40 days time limit for the tendering process);
 - Article 9.6.3 (written communication of modifications to tender documentation)
 - Article 9.11.2 (publication of a notice regarding the contract award)
 - Article 9.15.7(a) (time period provided to suppliers to prepare and submit written challenges).

Thereafter, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua shall fully comply with these obligations.

2. During the period between the entry into force of the Agreement and the end of the two-year transition period, Costa Rica shall provide at least 30 days for the *Licitación Pública* modality and 10 days for the *Licitación por registro* modality (Article 9.5.1), and three days for the time period provided to suppliers to prepare and submit written challenges (Article 9.15.7(a)).
3. During the period between the entry into force of the Agreement and the end of the two-year transition period, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua shall provide at least 30 days for the tendering process (Article 9.5.1), and at least five days for the time period provided to suppliers to prepare and submit written challenges (Article 9.15.7(a)).

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4. During the two years following the entry into force of this Agreement, Guatemala and Nicaragua shall make best efforts to comply with the following provision of this Chapter:
 - Article 13 (establishment and maintenance of systems that declare a supplier ineligible for participation).
5. During the period between the entry into force of the Agreement and the end of the two-year transition period, Guatemala and Nicaragua shall bind their current practice with respect to Article 13.
