

made in certain chapters, such as the financial negotiations group, not much substantial advancement was made regarding the key issues as both the US and Korea maintained their previous positions on the relevant sections.

- 4. The two sides concluded this round of negotiations sharing the belief that the two sides must step up the rate of progress made in the negotiations through additional face-to-face or video conferences, as necessary, and together search for points at which the parties' interests are balanced, based on the common understanding that it is now the time for both parties to show more flexibility and actively seek out mutually acceptable solutions.
- 5. The two parties agreed to hold the fourth round of negotiations in Korea (venue to be decided) from October 23 to 27, 2006.
